# **ROLE: Course Marshal**

### Your role will include:

- Marshalling the course and providing directional support for walkers
- Ensuring the course is clear and safe for participants at all times
- Reporting any issues on the course i.e. medical incidents, bottle necking, spectator invasion, etc. to your supervisor
- Adding atmosphere and encouraging walkers on the course
- Be a point of information for all participants

#### LOCATION:

You will be allocated a marshal point, please stay in close proximity to this point. Monitor the area around you.

### **STAFF COMMUNICATIONS:**

Your Supervisor will regularly patrol your area during the event, please direct any communication through them. You may be allocate with a two-way radio for communication with your Supervisor who will provide instruction on how to use it and procedures for use. You will also be informed how to attract attention quickly should an incident occur during the event. We suggest you also swap mobile numbers with your Supervisor during the event for emergencies.

## **MEDICAL & SECURITY:**

Medics and security staff will be placed strategically around the event, please familiarise yourself with their nearest location in relation to yourself.
